OKLAHOMA MEN COUNT MILLION DOLLAR SHOOT OUT RULES OF THE GAME

- 1. Only qualified players may participate in the shootout.**
- 2. Qualified players will consist of the registered players from the top 6 teams in the tournament.**
- 3. No substitutions will be allowed.**
- 4. The shoot out will take place after the tournament is complete.**
- 5. ONLY ELIGIBLE SHOTS ARE ALLOWED TO BE TAKEN AT THE PRIZE! – A “Shot” is defined as a “stroke” by the USGA Rules of Golf.**
- 6. In order for a shot to be eligible, it must be taken by an officially pre-registered or pre-qualified contestant that has amateur status. (No Golf Pros)**
- 7. Only one shot per contestant per target hole is permitted. Practice or qualifying shots, mulligans, or substitute shots for other contestants from the insured yardage are not permitted. A contestant is an “Amateur” if they meet the USGA Rules of Amateur Status on the date of the contest.**
- 8. A contestant that does not qualify as an “Amateur” is a “Professional.” Williams Media Group and IHIOA is not obligated to pay its members for a prize if the winner’s amateur or professional status is not correctly specified on the Contract.**
- 9. If a qualified player does make a legal hole in one. Verification must be sent to IHIOA. After verification payout will be made in a 40 year annuity.**
